

## The Statute

### of the Department of Sporting Events of the Moldavian Tennis Federation

1. The Department of Sporting Events (referred further to as the DSE) of the non-governmental organization "Moldova Tennis Federation" (referred further to as the MTF) is created aiming at the organization and inspection of the sporting events organized on the territory of the RM, the coordination of the activity of the subdivisions participating in the organization of the tournaments and directly in the process of the event, the improvement of the tournament calendar and the systems of conducting competitions on the territory of the RM.
2. The Department of Sporting Events of the MTF constitutes a consultative body of the MTF and has a character of recommendation.
3. The Department of Sporting Events of the MTF in its activity is guided by this Statute, the Constitution of MTF, the decisions of the President of the MTF, the Federal Bureau of the MTF and other statutory documents of the Tennis Federation of the Republic of Moldova.

#### Main goals of the DSE:

1. The organization and conduction of sporting events on the territory of the RM under the aegis of the MTF.
2. The inspection and checking of the fulfillment of all requirements and conditions for the conduction of the tournaments in correspondence with the stated category.
3. The submission of proposals connected to the improvement of the system of conducting sporting events on the territory of RM under the aegis of the MTF.
4. The checking of the condition of the sporting base and the approval of the possibility to organize certain events on their territory.
5. The submission of proposals to be approved by the President of the MTF and the members of the Federal Bureau of the MTF regarding the amount and successiveness of conducting the competitions included in the tournament calendar of the MTF.
6. The elaboration of a tournament calendar of the MTF for a year.
7. The elaboration of the Statute regarding the national tennis competitions and the Regulations regarding their conduction.
8. The elaboration of the statutory documents and methodical materials facilitating the organization and conduction of the competitions.
9. Together with the Judicial Assembly, the DSE of the MTF examines, in the established procedure, the claims and objections of the players and their representatives regarding the violation by the tournament's organizers of the Regulations of the MTF, the Tennis Play Rules and the statute regarding the conduction of competitions, as well as the violation by the players of the Player's Code and undertakes the corresponding measures.

### Organization of the obligatory activity of the DSE:

1. The DSE of the TFM consists of 7 people, constituting the representatives of all subdivisions of the MTF + one member of the Federal Bureau. One of these members is elected as the Chairman of the DSE.  
Note: The member of the Federal Bureau cannot be elected in the position of Chairman of the DSE, except for the separately examined cases.
2. The candidacy for the position of the Chairman of the DSE is proposed by the members of the DSE and is approved by the President of the MTF. In the event that this candidacy is not approved, the DSE must present within three days another candidacy. If the President of the MTF doesn't approve 3 candidatures presented by the DSE, the President appoints the Chairman of the DSE alone.
3. The Chairman of the DSE is elected for a period of 2 years.
4. The Chairman of the DSE is a member of the President's Council.
5. The DSE of the MTF must submit proposals to be approved by the President and the members of the Federal Bureau on matters connected to the organization and conduction of the sporting events and tournaments.
6. The DSE must submit reports regarding the conduction of a certain sporting event before the DSE session within not more than 5 days after the finishing of this event.
7. The sessions of the DSE are organized not less than once in a month, and whenever necessary (extraordinary sessions).
8. The information regarding the agenda of the sessions is presented to all members of the DSE 1 day before in the case of extraordinary sessions and 3 days before in the case of the obligatory sessions of the general meetings.
9. The DSE session is considered legitimate if the session comprises 1/2 of the members + one more DSE member.
10. The decisions within the DSE sessions are taken with the quantum of the votes.
11. Each member of the DSE has 1 vote.
12. All decisions of the DSE have a character of recommendation and come into force after their approval by the President of the MTF.
13. All decisions taken during the sessions of the DSE members are signed by the present DSE members and the minutes are drawn up.
14. The members of the DSE absent for more than 3 times during the DSE sessions without a grounded reason are excluded from the position of a DSE member. In this event, the DSE members must propose within three days a new candidate for approval by the President of the MTF. If the candidate is not presented within the corresponding term, the President of the MTF appoints a new member of the DSE alone.
15. All official documents of the DSE are placed on the MTF site.
16. In its activity, the DSE is regulated by the President of the MTF.
