

The Statute

of the Ranking Commission of the Moldavian Tennis Federation

1. The Ranking Commission (referred further to as the RC) of the non-governmental organization "Moldavian Tennis Federation" (referred further to as the MTF) is created aiming at the record-keeping, inspection, coordination and improving of the system of ranking-classification of the sportsmen of RM.
2. The Ranking Commission of the MTF constitutes a consultative body of the MTF and has a character of recommendation.
3. The Ranking Commission of the MTF in its activity is guided by this Statute, the Constitution of MTF, the decisions of the President of the MTF, the Federal Bureau of the MTF and other statutory documents of the Moldavian Tennis Federation.

RC tasks:

1. The analysis and examination of the progressive experience of other countries in the ranking system.
2. The submission of proposals by each member of the RC on issues connected to the improvement of the ranking-classification system of sportsmen of RM and making changes in the statute regarding the national MTF ranking of sportsmen of RM.

Organization of the obligatory activity of the RC:

1. The RC of the MTF consists of 5 people, constituting the representatives of all subdivisions of the MTF + one member of the Federal Bureau. One of these members is elected as the Chairman of the RC.
Note: The member of the Federal Bureau cannot be elected in the position of Chairman of the RC, except for the separately examined cases.
2. The candidacy for the position of the Chairman of the RC is proposed by the members of the RC and is approved by the President of the MTF. In case if this candidacy is not approved, the RC must present within three days another candidacy. If the President of the MTF doesn't approve 3 candidatures presented by the RC, the President appoints the Chairman of the RC alone.
3. The Chairman of the RC is elected for a period of 2 years.
4. The Chairman of the RC is a member of the President's Council.
5. The RC of the MTF must submit proposals to be approved by the President and the members of the Federal Bureau on matters connected to the ranking-classification system and scale of sportsmen of RM. These proposals shall be submitted in written as an obligatory condition before October 1 of the current year.
6. The members of the RC of MTF organize obligatory sessions monthly before the 1st day of each month for the approval of the MTF ranking for each month. The RC sessions (extraordinary sessions) may be organized when necessary.

7. The information regarding the agenda of the sessions is presented to all members of the RC 1 day before in the case of extraordinary sessions and 7 days before in the case of the obligatory sessions of the general meetings.
8. The RC session is considered legitimate if the session comprises 1/2 of the members + one more RC member.
9. The decisions within the RC sessions are taken with the quantum of the votes.
10. Each member of the RC has 1 vote.
11. All decisions of the RC have a character of recommendation and come into force after their approval by the President of the MTF.
12. All decisions taken during the sessions of the RC members are signed by the present RC members and the minutes are drawn up.
13. The members of the RC absent for more than 3 times during the RC sessions without a grounded reason are excluded from the position of a RC member. In this event, the RC members must propose within three days a new candidate for approval by the President of the MTF. If the candidate is not presented within the corresponding term, the President of the MTF appoints a new member of the RC alone.
14. All official documents of the RC are placed on the MTF web site.
15. In its activity, the RC is accountable to the President of the MTF.
