

Regulation of awarding Sports Titles

Tennis

*** According to the Order of the Minister of Youth and Sports, Mr. Ion Cebanu, № B/522 from 27.09.2010**

International Master of Sports

must fulfill one of the following requirements:

- be one of the 400 tennis players in the men's ranking ATP , singles, doubles;
- be one of the 300 tennis players in the women's ranking WTA, singles, doubles;

- win the I – IV place as a member of the Davis Cup team in the II group of the European-African zone;
- win the I - IV place as a member of the Fed Cup team in the II group of the European-African zone ;
- take part in the final of the European Junior Championship, singles (18 &U).

Master of Sports

must fulfill one of the following requirements:

- be one of the 800 tennis players in the men's ranking ATP , singles, doubles;
- be one of the 800 tennis players in the women's ranking WTA , singles, doubles.

- win the I-IV place as a member of the Davis Cup team in the III group of the European zone;
- win the I-IV place as a member of the Fed Cup team in the III group of the European-African zone ;
- win the I-IV place in the European Junior Championship , singles (16&U);
- win the I-VIII place in the European Junior Championship, singles (18&U);
- win the I-VIII place in the „Orange Bowl” world Championship, singles (18&U);
- win the I-VI as a member of the national team in the final round of the European Summer Cups (18&U);
- win the I-III place as a member of the national team in the final round of the European Summer (Winter) Cups (16&U);
- win the I-II place during 2 years in 5 tournaments of the ITF „Junior Circuit” calendar, grade 4,5 , singles;
- win I-II place during 2 years in 6 tournaments of the Tennis Europe „Junior Circuit” calendar, grade 2,3, singles (16&U);
- win I place in the National Championship of Republic of Moldova, singles, seniors (men, women);
- win I place in the „Masters” of RM, seniors (men, women).

Candidate for Master of Sports

must fulfill one of the following requirements:

- win I-XVI place in the European Junior Championship, singles (14,16&U);
- win I-IV place in the European Junior Championship, doubles (14,16&U);
- win I-III place as a member of the national team in the qualification round of the European Summer (Winter) Cups (14, 16&U), according to the maximal input;
- win I-VIII place during a period of one year in 5 tournaments of the ITF „Junior Circuit” calendar ,grade 4,5, singles;
- win the I-II place during a period of one year in 5 tournaments of the ITF „Junior Circuit” calendar, grade 4,5 doubles (18&U);
- win the I-II place during a period of one year in 5 tournaments of the Tennis Europe „Junior Circuit” calendar, 2 ,3, category, singles (14,16&U);
- win the II place in the National Championship of RM, singles, seniors (men, women); win the I place in the National Championship of RM, doubles, seniors (men, women);
- win the II place in „Masters” RM, seniors, (men, women).
- win the I-II place in the National Championship of RM, singles/doubles, 18&U (men, women).

I Category

must fulfill one of the following requirements:

- win the I - III places in the National Championship of RM , singles (14,16,18&U);
- win I-VIII place in 2 international tournaments of the Tennis Europe „Junior Circuit” calendar,2,3 category during a period of one year, singles, (14, 16&U);
- be part of the national team of RM ,selected for European Junior Championship.
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II Category

must fulfill one of the following requirements:

- win the I-VIII place in the National Championship of RM, singles (14,16,18&U) ;
- win the I-XVI place in 3 international tournaments of the Tennis Europe „Junior Circuit” calendar 2,3 category for a period of one year, singles, (14,16&U);
- to be part of the national team of the RM, selected for the Summer (Winter) European Cups.
